






Comparable examples

- Comparing different project generators (QC focus) & a drilling company as an example of a service company
 - → Peaks on discoveries for the project generators
 - Peaks on bull market cycles for both service companies and project generators
 - Cope better with prolonged bear markets
 - → Low dilution even after 20+ yrs of operation
- Not showing royalty companies and equity holdings shorter timeframe & more active M&A




